He graduated with a medical degree from Beijing Medical University(1983), after which he went on to complete further training as a Visiting Scholar at Les Hôpitaux Universitaires de Strasbourg, France(1992-1993) and then at the Columbia School of Physicians and Surgeons, US. Prior to assuming his present appointment(1999-2000), he held the position of Attending Physician before being promoted to Professor and Deputy Director of the Department of Surgery, Beijing Medical University, China.(2000-). Currently, he is president of Shougang Hospital Peking University.

#### Professional Experience

Professor Gu's current research interests in the field of colorectal cancer include diagnosis, multidisciplinary management, staging, chemotherapeutic options and individualised therapy. He has won numerous prestigious national awards for his research endeavours. To date, he has authored and co-authored more than 120 scholarly papers in distinguished peer-reviewed journals such as *Cancer*, *World Journal of Gastroenterology*, *Ann Surg*, *Clinical Cancer Research*, and *Diseases of the Colon & Rectum*.
