Brief Biography

Hideki Ueno, M.D., Ph.D., is a colorectal surgeon and is currently the chairperson of Japanese Classification of Colorectal Carcinoma Revision Committee in the JSCCR (Japanese Society for Cancer of the Colon and Rectum), as well as that of the Database Committee in the JSGS (Japanese Society of Gastroenterological Surgery) for NCD (National Clinical Database). Clinical implication of surgical pathology is one of his research interests and he had proposed original pathological assessment criteria for tumor dedifferentiation and fibrotic cancer stroma with some international colleagues such as ITBCC (International Tumor Budding Consensus Conference) members. His work spans JSCCR multicenter studies, NCD research, JCOG (Japan Clinical Oncology Group) phase III trials, and molecular biological research into molecular mechanism behind tumor heterogeneity in collaboration with Japanese and global researchers.
